Applicant, Panhandle Geological Society Scholarship

The PGS scholarship is awarded to qualified graduating high school seniors from the Amarillo area intending to major in geology as well as undergraduate or graduate degree students currently enrolled in a geology program in regional universities. Please note that preference is given to those applicants that are student members of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists (AAPG).

The award is \$1000/school year (\$500/semester) and is awarded to four students on an annual basis. Recipients may be awarded the scholarship multiple times but must re-apply for the scholarship each year by the application deadline. Applicants must have, and maintain, an overall 3.0 GPA.

In order to complete your application package, we require the following:

- 1) Completed scholarship application (enclosed).
- 2) One copy of your most recent college transcript. If you are a graduating high school senior, one copy of your latest high school transcript (unofficial copies of transcripts are sufficient).
- 3) Copy of upcoming semester schedule.
- 4) Two letters of reference.
- 5) Application deadline is September 15
